Summer 2026 Emergency Medical Responder Class Weekday classes

An Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) provides initial, basic life support (BLS) and patient stabilization while working with EMS agencies or fire departments.

Certification requires being at least 16 years old, completing a 70 hour course, holding current CPR certification, and passing both NREMT cognitive (written) and PA psychomotor (practical) exams.

Classes will be a combination of online self-study and in-person lecture and skills.
