## **COURSE FEES** \$400.00

This cost does not include books, test fee, or clearance fees. **Emergency Medical Technicians** provide out of hospital emergency medical care and transportation for critical and emergent patients who access the emergency medical services (EMS) system. EMTs have the basic knowledge and skills necessary to stabilize and safely transport patients ranging from non-emergency and routine medical transports to life threatening emergencies. Emergency Medical Technicians function as part of a comprehensive EMS response system, under medical oversight. Emergency Medical Technicians perform interventions with the basic equipment typically found on an ambulance. Emergency Medical Technicians are a critical link between the scene of an emergency and the health care system. [From the: *National EMS Scope of Practice Model*]

#### **Pre-requisites:**

Students enrolling in this course are required to read, write, and have good oral command of the English language. Students are required to be **16 years of age**. All students are required to bring the following documentation during registration: as they are required by state regulation:

- Current TB test
- PA Childline Clearance
- PA Criminal History
- NYS Criminal History (NYS students only)
