Course Overview

Emergency Medical Technicians (EMT) provide out of hospital emergency medical care and transportation for critical and emergent patients who access the emergency medical services (EMS) system. EMTs have the basic knowledge and skills necessary to stabilize and safely transport patients ranging from nonemergency and routine medical transports to life threatening emergencies. Emergency Medical Technicians function as part of a comprehensive EMS response system, under medical oversight. Emergency Medical Technicians perform interventions with the basic equipment typically found on an ambulance. Emergency Medical Technicians are a critical link between the scene of an emergency and the health care system.

The EMT course is an average of 200 hours of instruction that covers the following in accordance with the National EMS Education Standards and provides students with the knowledge and skills to needed:

- Anatomy and physiology
- Assessment of injuries and illnesses (Medical and Trauma)
- Assisting patients with their own prescribed medications
- Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and automated external defibrillation (AED)
- Environmental emergencies
- Lifting, moving and transportation of patients
- Pediatric and geriatric emergencies
- The overall roles and responsibilities of the EMT

The EMT Program requires mandatory prerequisite courses listed below. These courses can be completed at <https://training.fema.gov>

- IS-5.A: An Introduction Hazardous Materials
- NIMS IS-100.C: Introduction to Incident Command System (ICS)
- NIMS IS-700.B: National Incident Management System (NIMS), An Introduction



This program is designed to meet all National requirements to prepare for the EMT exam given by the National Registry of Emergency Medication Technicians (NREMT).
