



# Emergency Medical Technician Course

Our Emergency Medical Technician (“EMT”) program is designed to train the lay person in the initial basic emergency medical care in the pre-hospital environment. EMT students receive education and training in:

- Basic knowledge and skills needed to provide safe patient care in a wide variety of scenarios
- Airway management, respiration, and artificial ventilation
- Medical and trauma patient assessments
- Medical emergencies (respiratory, cardiac, diabetic, abdominal, renal and hematologic, behavioral and psychiatric, poisoning and overdose, allergic reactions, and more)
- Traumas (bleeding and shock, soft-tissue, chest and abdominal, musculoskeletal, head/neck/spine, multi system, environmental, and more)
- EMS operations, along with an introduction to specialty situations such as haz-mat, terrorism, and MCIs

This class will meet on Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and occasionally on Saturday. The PCTC course is designed to provide each student with lecture-based instruction as well as hands-on practical skills training. All students will be required to complete clinical time with one of our many affiliated clinical partners. Successful completion of the course qualifies the student to test for both their PA state EMT and National Registry EMT certifications.
