The Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Course is a fast-paced, 13 week program consists of approximately 190 hours of both didactic and practical training to prepare candidates for an emergency medical response.

The Training Includes:

- The basic knowledge and skills needed to provide safe patient care in a variety of scenarios.
- An introduction to specialty situations such as: hazardous materials, terrorism, and mass casualty incidents.
- Safe patient packaging and transport to an appropriate medical facility.
- Professional interaction and communication with advanced providers both in the field and hospital setting.

Tuition: \$750.00

<u>Pay-to-train Available</u>: Applicants accepted into this program will earn a taxable wage of 10.50/hr. while this training program is in session. Prospective students will be required to sign a 1-year full-time employment agreement with Pennsylvania Ambulance upon attainment of their EMT Certificate.

This course has been approved by the Pennsylvania Department of Health as meeting the educational course requirement that an applicant for certification as an EMT needs to satisfy to be certified by the Pennsylvania Department of Health as an EMT.
