The Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Academy is a fast-paced, 8 week program consists of approximately 190 hours of both didactic and practical training to prepare candidates for an emergency medical response.

New employees would enter Pennsylvania Ambulance's workforce on a pay-to-train track. Candidates will be hired full time and will be paid to attend this accelerated eight (8) week EMT program. The class will be 40 hours a week with limited over-time.

After successful completion of the program and certification, new graduates will be employed by Pennsylvania Ambulance at the starting EMT rate.

The Training Includes:

- The basic knowledge and skills needed to provide safe patient care in a variety of scenarios.
- An introduction to specialty situations such as: hazardous materials, terrorism, and mass casualty incidents.
- Safe patient packaging and transport to an appropriate medical facility.
- Professional interaction and communication with advanced providers both in the field and hospital setting

This course is open to non-employee candidates based on availability.

This course has been approved by the Pennsylvania Department of Health as meeting the educational course requirement that an applicant for certification as an EMT needs to satisfy to be certified by the Pennsylvania Department of Health as an EMT.
