COURSE DESCRIPTION

The EMT course covers all techniques of emergency medical care presently considered within the responsibilities of the EMT, as well as operational aspects of the job which they will be expected to perform. The course consists of approximately **60 lessons**, involving approximately **190 hours** of classroom and field training. Specific objectives of the course are: 1) Teach students the overall role and responsibilities of the EMT in performing both the emergency care and operational aspects of the job; 2) Develop student skills in patient assessment and all emergency treatment procedures, and 3) Develop student skills in the use and care of all equipment required to accomplish the job. The course is taught to the most current National EMS Education Standards.

PREREQUISITES

This course is designed for all individuals desiring to provide emergency medical care with an ambulance agency or other pre-hospital rescue service, routinely providing emergency care. Persons enrolling in the course are required to read, write, and have good oral command of the English language. Enrollees must be sixteen (16) years of age by the end of the class. **Proof of a Booster Tetanus shot within ten years and a current TB test within one year are required.**

COURSE FEE

Tuition for the course, including all instructional materials and supplies is **\$200.00** as it is funded in part by a Rural EMS Training Initiative Grant.

Checks or money orders should be made payable to EMSNP. Any person who has not pre-registered must be prepared to make full payment to EMSNP on registration night. A \$20.00 charge will be applied for any returned checks. All students will be responsible for the NREMT Cognitive Computer Adaptive fee. See the NREMT website at www.nremt.org for current fee.

PRE-REGISTRATION

Individuals shall pre-register by completing the enclosed application and returning it with the \$200.00 tuition. Deadline for pre-registration is Friday, September 25, 2026. Individuals who fail to pre-register will be accepted on a "space available" basis.

Applications received without payment of the registration fee will be deemed not to have pre-registered.
