

All ALS Providers at the Paramedic Level and above now have an Expiration for their registration. Effective January 1, 2014 all ALS level providers are required to complete 36 CEU's of which 27 must meet the clinical patient care category. Some practitioners will have an expiration date less than two years from this date and the con-ed will be prorated for their shortened registration period. Con-ed will be calculated from January 1, 2014.

The following chart will help assist in figuring out the con-ed required

Please have your ALS Practitioners log into the EMS Registry Portal and check their expiration date and their con-ed to see where they stand with their con-ed Credits in correlation to their expiration date. AS a reminder they will also need to submit a CPR card to our office to show completion of the course during their recognition period.
