The inaugural PA EMS Memorial Bike Ride from the Flight 93 Memorial in Shanksville, PA to Harrisburg, PA will take place on September 10, 11 and 12th, 2016.

This ride will start in our National Park of the Flight 93 Memorial and end 147 miles later on the steps of the State Capitol Rotunda in Harrisburg.

Enjoy the beautiful scenery as we start at one of the highest points of the Laurel Highlands Mountains, making our way downward to the towns of Breezewood, Carlisle and Harrisburg.
