### **FW: PennDOT's Scheduled Roadwork for the Week September 22 to September 29, 2017**

### **PA TURNPIKE**

The Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission is scheduled to replace two bridges later this month — one in Beaver County and one in Lehigh County — using a proven engineering technique that allows workers to replace a bridge in one weekend rather than a year or more of construction. "The Accelerated Bridge Construction process is a cost-effective way to replace bridges within a short timeframe while reducing worker exposure in construction zones which in turn improves safety for workers and motorists alike," PA Turnpike CEO Mark Compton said. "It also eliminates the need for months or years of cattle chutes, single-lane traffic patterns and other restrictions for motorists."

The second closure will take place from 9 p.m. Friday, Sept 29, through 4 p.m., Monday, Oct 2, on the Northeastern Extension (Interstate 476, milepost 57.66) in Lehigh County. The detour exits are the Lehigh Valley Interchange (#56) for northbound traffic and the Pocono Interchange (#95) in for southbound traffic. The authorized detour route directs motorists to Route 22, Route 33 and Interstate 80. (Note: Local travelers heading southbound on the PA Turnpike will be able to drive past (#95) in for southbound traffic. The authorized

detour route directs motorists to Route 22, Route 33 and Interstate 80 (Note: Local travelers heading southbound on the PA Turnpike will be able to drive past #95/ Pocono and continue to exit at [#87/Route 903](#) E-ZPass only or #74/Mahoning Valley. The Turnpike will be closed southbound at Mahoning Valley.)

- During the Sept 29 detour, crews will demolish and replace a bridge carrying the Northeastern Extension (1-476) over Crackersport Road in South Whitehall Township, Lehigh County. The 131-foot long bridge opened to traffic on Nov 7, 1957 and today carries roughly 30,000 vehicles per day, combined north/south.

The Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission advises motorists that the Northeastern Extension (I-476) will be closed in both directions on Sept. 24 from 12:01 to 6 a.m. between the Lansdale Interchange, Exit 31, Montgomery County, and the Quakertown Interchange, Exit 44, Bucks County.

The closure is necessary to protect travelers and workers so crews can set bridge beams. The bridge, which carries Harleysville Pike over the Turnpike, crosses I-476 at milepost A33.88 in Montgomery County. At 12:01 a.m. on Sept. 24, all northbound traffic must exit at the Lansdale Interchange and southbound traffic will be diverted off at the Quakertown Interchange. Some single-lane closures and traffic stoppages may occur Sept. 23 during the night-time hours to prepare for the closure.

## **Interstate 80**

### **- Short Term**

There will be NBIS Bridge Inspections closure/restriction on I-80 mile marker 260 B and 260 A both lanes. 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Thursday, September 28.

### **Long Term**

Exit 273 (White Haven/Freeland) to Exit 260 (Wilkes Barre/Harrisburg)-Work is being done for the rehabilitation and resurfacing of I-80 westbound from Exit 273 (White Haven/Freeland) to roughly half a mile east of Exit 260 (Wilkes Barre/Harrisburg) on I-81. Traffic is down to a single lane until November. This work will end in November, and then continue in April of 2018 and go until May of 2018. There will

be lane closures during the construction period and a detour will be in place using Exit 274/Hickory Run State Park and Route 940 through White Haven.

## **Interstate 81**

### **- Short Term**

There will traffic issues on I-81 at Montage Mountain, Lackawanna County due to weekend activities at the baseball stadium starting Friday, September 22, 2017.

I-81 Susquehanna County the contractor will have multiple lane closures both northbound and southbound 24 hours next week, starting Monday morning at 12:00 am.

They will be closing the on and off ramps at exits 223, 211, and 206 throughout week during the night from 8:00 pm to 6:00 am for paving. Detours will be in place.

Lane closures and moving patterns will continue throughout the week from Monday through Friday both northbound and southbound for line painting and guide rail work.

### **Long Term**

Exit [170 \(Bear Creek/Wilkes Barre\)](#) and Exit 178 (Avoca/Wilkes Barre Scranton Airport)-Construction is taking place on I-81 North and South between these exits. PennDOT is replacing four, old 2-lane bridges with new 3-lane bridges. There are two lane shifts taking place northbound. However, there are two lanes open throughout the entirety of that work. The purpose of this project is to widen the bridges in preparation for the widening of I-81 that PennDOT hopes to do in the future. The project should be completed by late fall.

Exit 175 (Pittston) -Traffic patterns changes will include a split roughly 1,000 feet north of this exit. These changes will be in place until October. Crews use the split pattern so they can do work in the middle lane while still maintaining two lanes of traffic.

Exit 175 (Dupont/Pittston) -The Armstrong Drive widening project going from Exit 175 to SR 315 northbound at Oak Street is now

complete. The completion of this project allows for three lanes of traffic to come off the exit ramp.

Exits 199 (Scott), 201 (East Benton), and 202 (Fleetville/Tompkinsville)- There are several bridges being replaced in Spring of 2017.

Exit 202 (Fleetville/Tompkinsville) to Exit 199 (Scott)-Work is being done for the replacement of bridge decks, causing single lane traffic in this location until November. A detour will take traffic on to I-81 northbound to Exit 206 (Lenoxville).

Exit 202 (Fleetville/Tompkinsville) to Exit 230 (Great Bend/Susquehanna)- The pavement preservation project began on May 1, causing multiple single lane closures in both the northbound and southbound directions. The lane restrictions will be in place until November, with the exception of being removed over the weekends barring any emergencies.

## **Interstate 84**

### **- Short Term**

### **Long Term**

Exit 30 (Blooming Grove/Porters Lake) to Exit 46 (Milford)- Crews are working on roadway and bridge reconstruction work between these exits. Traffic is currently in a single lane configuration, with westbound traffic traveling within the eastbound travel lanes via cross-overs. Traffic is scheduled to stay in this configuration until November 2017. Three westbound structures and approximately 3.5 miles of westbound interstate roadway are to be completed during this construction

season. No permanent lane closures will be allowed during the winter months. The project is scheduled to be completed by October 2019.

## **Long Term**

SR [6/11 \(Lackawanna Trail\)](#)- From Clarks Summit to Clinton, traffic will be down to a single lane in both directions due to construction. Crews should be finished with this work in November 2017. The following spring, crews will begin working near Dalton. When that is complete, final pave will take place at night. Starting May 15, 2018, through the middle of June, 2018, crews will be paving from Clarks Summit to Dalton, then Dalton to Wyoming County. Starting on Wednesday, July 5 from Sr 632(Dalton) to Overlook Rd all traffic will be on the east bond lane so work could continue on the west bond lane. This will be continue till Oct 1, 2017.

SR 307 Schultsville Rd, Newton, Township there will be a single lane closure with a temporary traffic signal for replacement of a culvert. The project should take three months.

SR 347 (O'Neill Highway/Blakely Street)- Dunmore Signal Project work is progressing as crews continue to pour concrete sidewalks near the Subway entrance. They are also erecting traffic signal foundations at Rite Aid. In roughly three weeks, crews will start work at the Dunmore Corners section. Traffic will be down to one lane in this area. The entire project is scheduled to be completed by November 2017.

SR 1012, Archbald Borough- At the intersection of Kennedy Drive and County Road, work is taking place to form a four-way intersection with

the opposite Borough street. A new traffic signal will be installed at this intersection as well, and Kennedy Drive will be widened to accommodate a center turn lane from Main Street to Monica Drive. An additional left turn lane may be added on Main for left turns on to Kennedy Drive. The project should be completed by December 2017.

SR 3013 - Work is taking place on the bridge located in the 800 block of S. Main Street in Taylor over the PA turnpike. Two 11 ft. lanes will remain open during construction. This should be completed by November.

SR 4032 (Shady Lane) in South Abington Twp.- There will be work on a section of state highway from approximately 0.09 miles west of SR 11 to approximately 0.17 miles east of SR 307. This project will replace the existing slab on the bridge under the concrete arch associated with the DL&W Railroad with a new slab. MPT during the construction will be a detour. This project is expected to be completed by November.

SR 6011(Harrison Avenue), Scranton - As part of the ongoing project to replace the Harrison Avenue Bridge, the Central Scranton Expressway is a single lane pattern in each direction. This project is expected to be completed in 2018.

SR 438 Lackawanna County to your long term construction list. SR 438 is closed over Elm Brook at Hopfer Road for a bridge replacement Project. Road to reopen in November. Detours in place.

### **Luzerne County**

#### **- Short Term**

This weekend.. Hazelton Area Police departments will be conducting DUI checkpoints and roving patrols.

Beginning Sunday night (9/24) a ramp paving project will begin. The ramps are on Sr309 (North Cross Valley) and the work is scheduled from 8 PM to 5 AM. The contractor plans to work Sunday night September 24 through Thursday night September 28 weather permitting. The project is scheduled to be completed by Dec. 4 the ramps to be done are Exit [1\(Kidder St\)](#), exit [2 \(Wilkes-Barre Blvd.\)](#), Exit [4 \( Rutter Ave.\)](#), Exit [5 \(Wyoming Ave\)](#) and Exit 6 (Luzerne). The work will begin on exit 1 and 2 week of Sept 24, 2017.

## **Long Term**

SR 29 between Exit 2 and Exit 3- There is currently a single lane closure in both directions for work on the South Valley Parkway Project. The lane closures are scheduled to last for the next 12 months. Routine blasting will occur throughout this area. There will be rolling roadblocks during blasting. Middle Road was closed and detoured April 3, 2017, and will reopen in November of 2017. Kosciuszko Street will be closed July 10, 2017 and reopened in September of 2017. Prospect Street will be closed in the summer of 2018 and reopen in November 2018.

SR 309- A new traffic pattern began back in April on Rutter Ave. Traffic on Rutter Ave. crossing over the bridge heading west from Wells St. towards East Bennett St. is down to one straight lane. There is one left turn lane over the Rutter Ave. bridge to access SR 309 SB (North Cross Valley Expressway). Traffic on Rutter Ave. heading east from East Bennett St. towards Wells St. follows the signed detour to SR 309 SB to Exit 3 (River St.). Traffic then makes a left on River St. and then another left to get on SR 309 NB. Traffic then gets off SR 309 NB at Exit 4 to Rutter Ave. on the east side of the Rutter Ave. bridge. Phase 1 construction duration will be approximately three months.

Traffic on Rutter Ave. heading east from East Bennett St. towards Wells St. will continue to follow the signed detour to SR 309 SB to Exit #3 (River St.). Traffic will then make a left on River St. and then make another left to get on SR 309 NB. Traffic will then get off SR 309 NB at Exit #4 to Rutter Ave. on the east side of the Rutter Ave. bridge. Temporary concrete barrier is scheduled to be placed Monday July 17, 2017. Phase 2 construction duration will be approximately two to three months.

SR 415 (The Dallas 5-Leg project)- The Dallas 5-Leg project is a cooperative project between The Back Mountain Council of Governments, local municipalities, and PennDOT. Work includes the



realignment of SR 1041 (Upper Demunds Road) and the installation of a new single-lane roundabout at the 5-Leg Intersection in Dallas Borough. Throughout the course of work, periodic detours will be in place and significant delays are anticipated. This project is expected to be completed by June of 2019.

SR 7220- Bridge Replacement of County Bridge #26304 that carries Old Route 11 (Main Street) over Toby Creek in Kingston Township. The proposed bridge will include concrete abutments with spread footings. A one mile detour will be utilized during construction. Other work includes bituminous paving, line painting and guiderail work. This is a local project, not a PennDOT project. This project is expected to be completed by July of 2019.

Lake St in Dallas will be closed starting on Tuesday, August 29 for one year as part of the Dallas Roundabout project. A detour will be in place from Center Hill Rd to Sterling Ave and back to Machell Rd.

### **Long Term**

Pond Eddy – The concrete work at the New York pier is finished, steel beams from the New York abutment to the center pier are set, and the super structure is finished. The contractor is now building the wooden forms for the concrete bridge deck and railing. Contractors will be setting the decks starting in mid-October. The bridge is on schedule to be completed by December 2019,

SR 2004, Silver Lake Rd to Lake Marcell- The work taking place here consists of edge repairs, pipe replacements, and a bridge deck replacement near Lake Marcell. This project will continue until the fall. The road will be resurfaced in 2018.

Construction for the Log Tavern Road (Route 2006) bridge over Dwarf Kill Creek in Pike County, is scheduled to begin as part of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation's (PennDOT) Rapid Bridge Replacement Project. Replacement of this bridge will allow PennDOT to remove it from Pike County's structurally deficient bridge list. Motorists should be prepared for a traffic change on Thursday, August 31. During this time, an alternating traffic pattern will be controlled by temporary traffic signals. Construction of the new bridge is anticipated to be complete in December.

This bridge was replaced as part of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation's (PennDOT) Rapid Bridge Replacement Project and allows PennDOT to remove it from the state's structurally deficient bridge list. With the bridge reopened, motorists may notice a slight bump as they drive across the bridge until a polyester polymer concrete (PPC) overlay is applied to the deck. This is often the final step in completing box beam bridge projects. The PPC overlay is designed to protect the deck from the wear and tear brought about by

Pennsylvania's harsh winters and reduce the long-term maintenance costs.

SR 1010 Harmony road Segment 20. Slope repair. Road closure with detour. This is a long term operation. Work begins August 8<sup>th</sup> thru November 6<sup>th</sup> .

SR 3037 (Rush Twp.)- There is a bridge closure from the intersection of SR 367 to the intersection of SR 267 in Rush Township. The bridge is closed due to pier deficiency. A detour is posted.

The scheduled bridge replacement for the Route 11 (Main Street) bridge over Fishing Creek in New Milford Township in Susquehanna County has been postponed. It was previously scheduled to begin during the week of August 28. Construction is now expected to begin during the week of September 11 and be complete in April, 2018. During this time, an alternating traffic pattern will be controlled by temporary traffic signals. In the event of unfavorable weather or unforeseen activities, this schedule may still change

SR 170-Creek Drive Clinton Twp. Emergency/Immediate Bridge Closure (Aldenville) Detour will be in place. Work should be completed by end of September.

SR 191 over Dyberry Creek, Honesdale Borough- The work here consists of the rehabilitation of an existing two span I-beam bridge, new retaining wall, temporary pedestrian bridge, temporary traffic signal, traffic detour, rock embankment, sidewalk and curbs, guiderail, and pavement markings. Work is expected to be complete by October 2017.

SR 652- Narrowsburg Bridge Inc. Mobilization is scheduled to be complete by September of 2018. The proposed work consists of the rehabilitation of a steel deck arch bridge over the Delaware River, along with some other work. The controlled one-lane traffic pattern will continue throughout construction apart from 15 overnight closures needed.

SR 3004- There is a bridge deck replacement project over West Branch of Wallenpaupack Creek (Salem/Sterling Townships) at the intersection of Moon Road, Pond Road, Callapoose Road, and Cemetery Road. The roadway will be completely closed during this time. Work is expected to be complete by September.

SR 3019 over Jones Creek, Lake Township- Construction work here consists of the replacement of a steel I-beam bridge, along with other various projects. This is expected to be complete by November 2017.

## **Wyoming County**

### **- Short Term**

Paving to start on SR 3006(Tioga St.). The contractor will be begin paving Monday, September 25 at 8:30am, They will be starting at the intersection of SR 3006 and SR 0006 (Ace Robbins) and continue west. The goal for the day is to reach the west side of Warren St. for the day.

The reason for the later start on paving is after field viewing and studying the volume of traffic over the last few days it appears that the high volume of traffic tends to thin out between 8:00am and 8:30am. The contractor superintendent have decided that starting

after 8:00am may alleviate some of the back log and give time for the school buses to complete their routes with less interruption. The contractor has a goal of being west of the down town business's by noon so to keep interruption to the establishments along Tioga St. minimal during the lunch hour. **It is important to point out that this layer that we will be placing is only the scratch/leveling course, the wearing/top course will be placed after the scratch course is complete.** Parking will be restricted on both sides of Tioga St. starting at Warren St. and ending at Pine St. for the day or until the contractor has completed the work in this area.

Also note that the cleaning crew needs to begin at 6 a.m. to get a head start on the paving crew which should not cause much interruption to traffic and all traffic will be controlled by flaggers.

The start date is August 2017 and completion is scheduled for Oct 2018.

The proposed project consists of an existing single span, reinforced concrete T-beam bridge being replaced with a Single Span, P/S Concrete Composite Spread Box Beam Bridge over Miller Brook. Other proposed work includes roadway approach full depth bituminous paving; excavation; drainage; guiderail; landscaping; signing; pavement markings; temporary traffic control; detour signing; E & S



Control measures; bridge removal and other miscellaneous construction .
