PennDOT's Scheduled Roadwork for the Week November 17, 2017 to November 22, 2017

Motorists traveling through Northeastern Pennsylvania are encouraged to take a safety break at interstate rest areas over the Thanksgiving Holiday weekend. Community groups will serve free coffee at rest areas through a program coordinated with PennDOT that's designed to encourage drivers to "Take a Break for Safety's Sake" during the busy holiday travel period from November 23 through November 28. Breaks will be held at rest areas on Interstates 80, 81, and 84 as well as the Matamoras Welcome Center and the Great Bend Welcome Center.

PA TURNPIKE

- Express E-ZPass Ramp Closure Scheduled for Nov. 20 at Lansdale Interchange

Six-hour closure needed for toll equipment maintenance.

The Pennsylvania Turnpike advises motorists traveling on the Northeastern Extension (I-476) to the Lansdale Interchange, Exit 31, Montgomery County, to be prepared for slow-moving or stopped traffic.

From 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Nov. 20, the southbound Express E-ZPass entry ramp will be closed for planned maintenance work of the overhead and underground tolling equipment.

Work schedules are subject to change based on weather conditions.

Interstate 80

- Short Term

Exit 273 (White Haven/Freeland) to Exit 260 (Wilkes Barre/Harrisburg)-Work is being done for the rehabilitation and resurfacing of I-80 westbound from Exit 273 (White Haven/Freeland) to roughly half a mile east of Exit 260 (Wilkes Barre/Harrisburg) on I-81. Traffic is down to a single lane until November. This work will end in November, and then continue in April of 2018 and go until May of 2018. There will be lane closures during the construction period and a detour will be in place using Exit 274/Hickory Run State Park and Route 940 through White Haven.

Interstate 81

- Short Term

The contractor has completed the pavement preservation project on I-81 in Susquehanna County. We do not anticipate any further lane closures for this project.

Long Term

Exit 170 (Bear Creek/Wilkes Barre) and Exit 178 (Avoca/Wilkes Barre Scranton Airport)-Construction is taking place on I-81 North and South between these exits. PennDOT is replacing four, old 2-lane bridges with new 3-lane bridges. There are two lane shifts taking place northbound. However, there are two lanes open throughout the entirety of that work. The purpose of this project is to widen the bridges in preparation for the widening of I-81 that PennDOT hopes to do in the future. The project should be completed by November 2017.

Exit 175 (Pittston) -Traffic patterns changes will include a split roughly 1,000 feet north of this exit. These changes will be in place until October. Crews use the split pattern so they can do work in the middle lane while still maintaining two lanes of traffic.

Exit 175 (Dupont/Pittston) -The Armstrong Drive widening project going from Exit 175 to SR 315 northbound at Oak Street is now complete. The completion of this project allows for three lanes of traffic to come off the exit ramp.

Interstate 84

Exit 30 (Blooming Grove/Porters Lake) to Exit 46 (Milford)- Crews are working on roadway and bridge reconstruction work between these exits. Traffic is currently in a single lane configuration, with westbound traffic traveling within the eastbound travel lanes via cross-overs. Traffic is scheduled to stay in this configuration until November 2017. Three westbound structures and approximately 3.5 miles of westbound interstate roadway are to be completed during this construction season. No permanent lane closures will be allowed during the winter months. The project is scheduled to be completed by October 2019.

Interstate 380

- There will be traffic issues in downtown Scranton on Saturday, November 18 for the Annual Santa Parade from 7 a.m. to 12 p.m.

There will be traffic issues on Penn Ave, Scranton on Wednesday, November 22 for the Annual Scranton Times Tower lighting from 4 p.m. to 9 p.m.

There will be traffic issues on Sunday, November 26, on SR 2020(E. Drinker St) from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. for Home for the Holidays in Bucktown.

Long Term

SR 6/11 (Lackawanna Trail)- From Clarks Summit to Clinton, traffic will be down to a single lane in both directions due to construction. Crews should be finished with this work in November 2017. The following spring, crews will begin working near Dalton. When that is complete, final pave will take place at night. Starting May 15, 2018, through the middle of June, 2018, crews will be paving from Clarks Summit to Dalton, then Dalton to Wyoming County.

Starting on Wednesday, July 5 from Sr 632(Dalton) to Overlook Rd all traffic will be on the east bond lane so work could continue on the west bond lane. This will be continue till November 2017.

SR 307 Schultsville Rd, Newton, Township there will be a single lane closure with a temporary traffic signal for replacement of a culvert. The project should take three months.

SR 347 (O'Neill Highway/Blakely Street)- Dunmore Signal Project work is progressing as crews continue to pour concrete sidewalks near the Subway entrance. They are also erecting traffic signal foundations at Rite Aid. In roughly three weeks, crews will start work at the Dunmore Corners section. Traffic will be down to one lane in this area. The entire project is scheduled to be completed by November 2017.

SR 1012, Archbald Borough- At the intersection of Kennedy Drive and County Road, work is taking place to form a four-way intersection with the opposite Borough street. A new traffic signal will be installed at this intersection as well, and Kennedy Drive will be widened to accommodate a center turn lane from Main Street to Monica Drive. An additional left turn lane may be added on Main for left turns on to Kennedy Drive. The project should be completed by December 2017.

SR 3013 - Work is taking place on the bridge located in the 800 block of S. Main Street in Taylor over the PA turnpike. Two 11 ft. lanes will remain open during construction. This should be completed by November.

SR 6011(Harrison Avenue), Scranton - As part of the ongoing project to replace the Harrison Avenue Bridge, the Central Scranton Expressway is a single lane pattern in each direction. This project is expected to be completed in 2018.

SR 438 Lackawanna County to your long term construction list. SR 438 is closed over Elm Brook at Hopfer Road for a bridge replacement Project. Road to reopen in December. Detours in place.

Luzerne County

- There will be traffic issues on SR 2011 (West Carey Street (stretch from Main Street to Perkins Street) for the Annual Plains Lions Club Tree Lighting Ceremony to be held on Wednesday , November 22 from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m.

SR 29 between Exit 2 and Exit 3- There is currently a single lane closure in both directions for work on the South Valley Parkway Project. The lane closures are scheduled to last for the next 12 months. Routine blasting will occur throughout this area. There will be rolling roadblocks during blasting. Middle Road was closed and detoured April 3, 2017, and will reopen in November of 2017. Kosciuszko Street will be closed July 10, 2017 and reopened in September of 2017. Prospect Street will be closed in the summer of 2018 and reopen in November 2018.

SR 415 (The Dallas 5-Leg project)- The Dallas 5-Leg project is a cooperative project between The Back Mountain Council of Governments, local municipalities, and PennDOT. Work includes the realignment of SR 1041 (Upper Demunds Road) and the installation of a new single-lane roundabout at the 5-Leg Intersection in Dallas Borough. Throughout the course of work, periodic detours will be in place and significant delays are anticipated. This project is expected to be completed by June of 2019. Church St in Dallas will be closed from Wednesday, October 11 through Tuesday, October 31 for 21 days. Lake St will be open to businesses but not SR 415. Road closing signs will be moved on Lake St to parking lots of businesses. Church St be open at the bottom of the hill for access to CVS and the Post Office. Lake St in Dallas will be closed starting on Tuesday, August 29 for one year as part of the Dallas Roundabout project. A detour will be in place from Center Hill Rd to Sterling Ave and back to Machell Rd.

SR 7220- Bridge Replacement of County Bridge #26304 that carries Old Route 11 (Main Street) over Toby Creek in Kingston Township. The proposed bridge will include concrete abutments with spread footings. A one mile detour will be utilized during construction. Other work includes bituminous paving, line painting and guiderail work. This is a local project, not a PennDOT project. This project is expected to be completed by July of 2019.

Pike County

- SR 2006 -The bridge carrying Log Tavern Road (Route 2006) over Dwarfkill Creek in Dingman Township, Pike County is scheduled to close for one day on Wednesday, November 8, from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. for culvert placement work, as work continues as part of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation's (PennDOT) Rapid Bridge Replacement Project. During the

closure, motorists will be detoured along Milford Road (Route 2001) to Route 739. When the bridge reopens, Log Tavern Road will return to one lane of alternating traffic, with traffic signals, as crews complete the work on the replacement project. The bridge is anticipated to be complete in late November. Motorists are advised to allow extra time when traveling through the work area because slowdowns will occur during construction.

Pond Eddy updated 11-2. The concrete work at the New York pier is finished, steel beams from the New York abutment to the center pier are set, and the super structure is finished. The contractor is now building the wooden forms for the concrete bridge deck and railing. Contractors have finished setting the deck. On November 1 the contractor began working on the PA side of the bridge. They will work throughout the winter (weather dependent). The bridge is on schedule to be completed by December 2019,

SR 2004, Silver Lake Rd to Lake Marcell- The work taking place here consists of edge repairs, pipe replacements, and a bridge deck replacement near Lake Marcell. This project will continue until the fall. The road will be resurfaced in 2018.

Construction for the Log Tavern Road (Route 2006) bridge over Dwarf Kill Creek in Pike County, is scheduled to begin as part of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation's (PennDOT) Rapid Bridge Replacement Project. Replacement of this bridge will allow PennDOT to remove it from Pike County's structurally deficient bridge list. Motorists should be prepared for a traffic change on Thursday, August 31. During this time, an alternating traffic pattern will be controlled by temporary traffic signals. Construction of the new bridge is anticipated to be complete in December.

Susquehanna County

- There will be traffic issues on Saturday, December 2 on SR 171 (Main St) Forest City for the Holiday Tree Lighting Ceremony. 5 p.m. to 6 p.m.

Long Term

Route 11 (Main Street) bridge over Fishing Creek in New Milford Township in Susquehanna County has been postponed. It was previously scheduled to begin during the week of August 28. Construction is now expected to begin during the week of September 11 and be complete in April, 2018. During this time, an alternating traffic pattern will be controlled by temporary traffic signals. In the event of unfavorable weather or unforeseen activities, this schedule may still change

SR 167 in Hop Bottom- The road will be down to a single lane until late September.

SR 1010 Harmony road Segment 20. Slope repair. Road closure with detour. This is a long term operation. Work begins August 8th thru November 6th .

SR 3037 (Rush Twp.)- There is a bridge closure from the intersection of SR 367 to the intersection of SR 267 in Rush Township. The bridge is closed due to pier deficiency. A detour is posted.

Long Term

SR 191 over Dyberry Creek, Honesdale Borough- The work here consists of the rehabilitation of an existing two span I-beam bridge, new retaining wall, temporary pedestrian bridge, temporary traffic signal, traffic detour, rock embankment, sidewalk and curbs, guiderail, and pavement markings. Work is expected to be complete by Spring of 2018.

SR 652- Narrowsburg Bridge Inc. Mobilization is scheduled to be complete by September of 2018. The proposed work consists of the rehabilitation of a steel deck arch bridge over the Delaware River, along with some other work. The controlled one-lane traffic pattern will continue throughout construction apart from 15 overnight closures needed.

SR 3004- There is a bridge deck replacement project over West Branch of Wallenpaupack Creek (Salem/Sterling Townships) at the intersection of Moon

Road, Pond Road, Callapoose Road, and Cemetery Road. The roadway will be completely closed during this time. Work is expected to be complete by September.

SR 3019 over Jones Creek, Lake Township- Construction work here consists of the replacement of a steel I-beam bridge, along with other various projects. This is expected to be complete by November 2017.

Now open as of November 9, 2017 SR 1009 (Avery Station Road) in Lemon Township- The road is closed to all through traffic (open to local traffic only) for a bridge replacement project over Oxbow Creek. Construction will take place between Vago Road and Bob Henry Road. There is 10-mile detour in place for the traveling public. The project is expected to be completed by end of November 2017.

SR 87 over Miler Brook, North Branch Twp. for the rehabilitation and improvement of state highway North Branch Township,. The start date is August 2017 and completion is scheduled for Oct 2018. The proposed project consists of an existing single span, reinforced concrete T-beam bridge being replaced with a single span, concrete composite spread box beam bridge over Miller Brook. Other proposed work includes roadway approach full depth bituminous paving; excavation; drainage; guiderail; landscaping; signing;

pavement markings; temporary traffic control; detour signing; E & S Control measures; bridge removal and other miscellaneous construction .
SR 3007 Bridge is closed on (Vasburg Rd) Washington Twp. The bridge closed on October 26, 201. a detour is in place. Work should begin in the spring of 2018.
