Emergency Medical Technician Course

The Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Course is a fast-paced, 12 week program consists of approximately 190 hours of both didactic and practical training to prepare candidates for an emergency medical response.

The Training Includes:

After successful completion of the program, eligible graduates will be offered employment by Commonwealth Health EMS, and will have their course fees reimbursed. A sign-on bonus for graduates of the program will be payable at one year of service from graduation and two year of service from graduation date.

- The basic knowledge and skills needed to provide safe patient care in a variety of scenarios.
- An introduction to specialty situations such as: hazardous materials, terrorism, and mass casualty incidents.
- Safe patient packaging and transport to an appropriate medical facility.
- Professional interaction and communication with advanced providers both in the field and hospital setting

This course has been approved by the Pennsylvania Department of Health as meeting the educational course requirement that an applicant for certification as an EMT needs to satisfy to be certified by the Pennsylvania Department of Health as an EMT.
